# **Activities and Events**

- Hosted the "Saluting Our Stars" celebration event to recognize significant scholastic, artistic, and athletic achievements, as well as honor those individuals and businesses that made a significant impact on education and learning in Prince William County.
- Sponsored the 20th Annual "Tee Off for Education" Golf Classic fundraising event to support innovative grant funding to our departments and schools.
- Sponsored the third Prince William Community EXPO connecting parents and children with information related to school-based resources, health and fitness opportunities, child care programs, summer programs, and after school activities.






